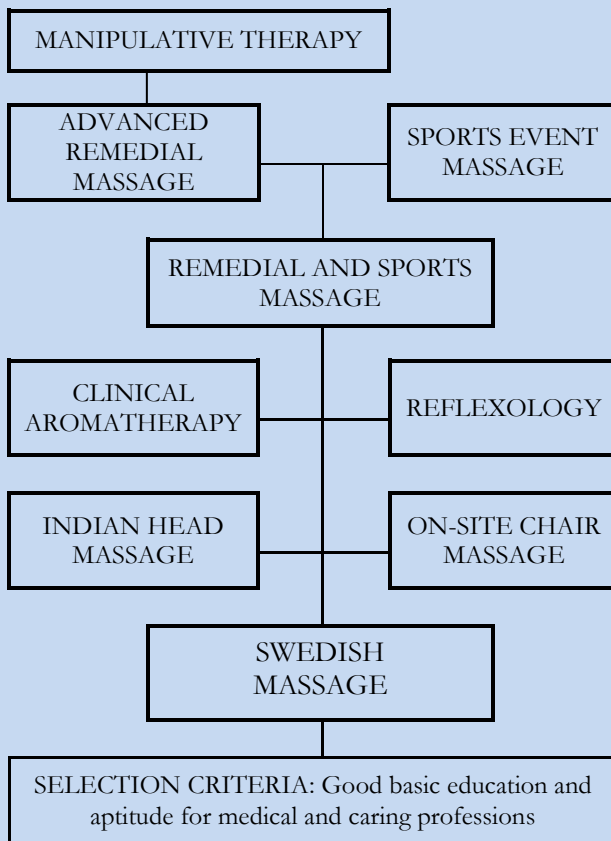

MANIPULATIVE THERAPY

Manipulative Therapy is the manipulation of the spine and other joints of the body.

CONTENT

The Manipulative Therapy course takes the student through examination of the spine; upper and lower joints of the limbs and formulating a differential diagnosis, with particular emphasis on assessment procedures and specific techniques for each joint.

MANIPULATIVE THERAPY

Manipulative Therapy involves manipulation of the full spine and pelvis; including specific techniques to assess and treat myofascial restrictions and joint stiffness; disc problems and spinal pathology. The methods and protocols build upon those learned in the Advanced Remedial Massage and works mainly on the mechanics of the body. The student will learn that correction of structural imbalances can have far-reaching effects on many conditions.

This course will further develop your skills and knowledge from your base as an Advanced Remedial Massage Therapist in treating many common complaints. The therapist is enabled to work more efficiently and effectively, minimising the impact on them and achieving sustained benefits for clients.
